Papers submitted in a preliminary version may also be considered, provided that the aim of the research, the methodological approach and the main results are clearly outlined. Papers based on European data and/or with relevant policy implications will be particularly appreciated. Submissions by European Supervisory Authorities and other National Competent Authorities will also be encouraged with the aim of strengthening the debate on financial supervisory issues.

Papers will be selected through a refereeing process managed by a **scientific committee** chaired by Massimo Guidolin (Bocconi University), Claudia Guagliano (ESMA) and Nadia Linciano (CONSOB) and endorsed by a **steering committee** composed of Donato Masciandaro (Bocconi University), Steffen Kern (ESMA) and Carmine Di Noia (CONSOB).
