CONSOB, ESMA and Bocconi University, through its BAFFI - CAREFIN research center, are organizing a conference on securities markets aimed at attracting original and highly policy-relevant research, on the following issues:

- 1 – financial innovation and systemic risk in securities markets;
- 2 – market microstructure, post-trading and market efficiency;
- 3 – securities markets development, institutional investors and SMEs growth;
- 4 – corporate governance issues: board functioning, shareholders engagement and remuneration;
- 5 – financial services and investor protection.
