Memorandum of Understandings (MoU) between Consob and the Public Prosecutor's Office of Rome

Information sharing and cooperation for the strengthening of mutual investigation activities

The agreement is focused on countering the obstacles to supervision and the financial unauthorized activities

Consob and the Public Prosecutor's Office of Rome have signed today a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) aimed at strengthening their respective investigation activities through a shared procedure for mutual exchange of both information and collaboration requests.

The MoU identifies the ways in which the two Authorities will be both able to ask for as well to exchange data, news and cooperation on subjects of mutual competence, within the current regulatory framework.

At the core of the MoU there are the activities needed for counteracting both the obstruction of Consob's supervisory activities and financial unauthorized activities as well. In both cases the Public Prosecutor's Office of Rome is often the judicial authority of reference to judge about possibly relevant activities for criminal laws.

The mutual cooperation mechanism also involves all the cases of market abuse in which the jurisdiction is rooted in the Court of Rome.

Consob and the Public Prosecutor's Office of Rome have also agreed both to examine all the issues of mutual interest during specific seminar sessions and to hold periodic meetings for mutually testing their respective cooperation mechanisms.
