### ***SECURITIES MARKETS: TRENDS, RISKS AND POLICIES***

***February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017, Milan***

ESMA, CONSOB and Bocconi University, through its BAFFI - CAREFIN research center, are organizing a conference on securities markets aimed at attracting original and highly policy-relevant research, on the following issues:
