Global Money Week 2023 starts on March 20th

"Plan your money, plant your future" is the theme of this edition of **Global Money Week**. Applications for the organization of events and initiatives throughout Italy are open on the Edufin Committee website. **You can apply until 13 March**.

The <u>Global Money Week</u> (GMW) is the annual event promoted by the OECD with the aim of raising young people's awareness of the importance of acquiring the knowledge, skills and behaviours necessary to make informed financial decisions.

Since its launch, in 2012, the event has involved over 50 million young people in 176 countries. In Italy, the campaign is coordinated by the Committee for the planning and coordination of financial education activities (Edufin Committee) with the organizational support of the Bank of Italy.

"*Plan your money, plant your future*" is a message emphasizing the strong link between planning one's finances and one's future with a view to sustainable development, with attention to the environment and to society.

The Edufin Committee invites associations, institutions, companies, universities and research centres, schools, foundations, public administrations and any other organization wishing to participate in the field of financial education with quality events. All the initiatives meeting the requirements of the Guidelines available on the official website <u>www.quellocheconta.gov.it</u> will be approved. Membership will allow you to use the official GMW logo and to take advantage from the many promotional activities, at national and local level, managed by the Committee to promote wider visibility to the organizers of the individual initiatives.
